SUBJECTIVE SECTION

He is up and wait by a pound. He presently receives insulin at 4 units twice daily of Levemir .. he used to be on Lantus, but this did not allow him a very good glucose curve. The glucose curve of the Levemir is not that much better, but he is able to gain weight. The low time (7 hours post-insulin) was just yesterday in the 50s. His present dose is 4 units twice daily. His mom checks his glucose level at pre-insulin and low times on a regular basis. He still has high water intake but that is not a new behavior for him. He is currently on fancy feast, Friskies, and was recently on just a little bit of Dr. elsie's dry. He typically gets Revolution, but is not presently current.

Attitude/Appearance

Anxious...with the carrier top off and towel over him I was able to auscultate his heart check his mouth and palpate his kidneys and comb his hair .. and that is all!

Oral Cavity/Teeth

Labwork was done in December .. owner does it frequently at home for that diabetes .. but due to kitty's anxiety and the fact that he recently gained weight, I think this needs to wait until the end of the year, unless something changes.

NOTES

I do recommend decreasing his insulin dose by 1 unit twice daily.
I believe we do need to decrease his food intake so that his weight is at least stable.
Make sure it does not get flea breakthrough.
