^a SDMA:

SDMA is normal, CREA high: can be due to fluctuations around the upper reference interval in well managed and stable kidney disease, post-prandial effects, or heavily muscled animals. Results will likely align with trended testing. Recommended next step: evaluation of other renal function tests, and complete urinalysis.

^b Pancreatic Lipase:

Pancreatic lipase is consistent with pancreatitis (8.8 U/L). If clinical signs are present, treat appropriately, and investigate for risk factors and concurrent diseases including enteritis, cholangitis, hepatic lipodosis and diabetes mellitus. Monitor Catalyst Pancreatic Lipase to assess response to treatment. If clinical signs are not present, consider additional diagnostics, instruct owner to monitor closely and recheck Catalyst Pancreatic Lipase in 2-3 weeks.
